OVERVIEW

Hill of Content are wines made by John Larchet, head of the newly created World Wine HeadQuarters, sourced from Clare Valley, McLaren Vale, Adelaide Hills, & Mornington Peninsula.

An outgrowth of The Australian Premium Wine Collection (TAPWC), World Wine HeadQuarters (WWHQ) is a new Larchet entity which has been on the drawing board for a number of years, given John's love and familiarity of fine wines from around the world, as well as his family connections. True to its name, WWHQ will comprise distinctive Wine Estates from both new and old world countries, with a key dimension that will distinguish it from other "worldly" portfolios.

Varieties: Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir, Grenache, Shiraz

Average Production: 5,000

"Hill of Content was born out of my desire to create interesting region specific wines at a price that allows for "liberal" consumption. The name translates as "Hill of Happiness", referring to a state of mind rather than geographic place. I hoped it would also be my own little way of seeking revenge against those "anonymous" glass pour wines that I am sure you to have tried and been disappointed by.....you know wines that are red or white, contain alcohol, but you would hardly strike up a conversation about. WINES

Pinot Noir Adelaide Hills

2007 Vintage: "Dark red. Smoky cherry and dark berry aromas. Juicy and gently sweet, with deep cherry/berry flavors, supple texture and no rough edges. Finishes plump, gently sweet and persistent, with the cherry note repeating. On the rich side of pinot and a good match for a peppery piece of grilled meat. 88 points." -

Cabernet Sauvignon Adelaide Hills

2009 Vintage: "Vivid purple. Fresh blackberry and blackcurrant aromas show good clarity and energy. Smooth and gently sweet, offering sappy dark fruit and candied rose flavors, supple tannins and a touch of black pepper. A blueberry note carries through the nicely persistent, spicy finish. 89 points." -

Grenache-Shiraz Old Vines Clare Valley

2007 Vintage: "Vivid ruby. Ripe blueberry and mulberry aromas are bright and expressive. Suave and fleshy, with ripe dark berry flavors, a hint of white pepper and no rough edges. Shows a lively mineral quality on the silky, focused finish.

Shiraz Clare Valley

2006 Vintage: "Deep ruby color. Blackberry and cocoa powder on the nose, with a hint of cracked pepper adding energy. Brisk red and dark berry flavors pack good punch and carry no excess weight. Silky tannins and a repeating peppery note give the finish of this stylish shiraz good thrust and grip. 88 points." -
