The winemaker, Attilio Pagli, a friend above all else, but also a winemaker of taste and integrity, both great rarities these days. The owners, Angela Corioni and Federigo Abbarchi, a couple whose dedication to quality is indisputable.

The wines are the final result of all the above. Like few others they embody the qualities that made

Brunello famous: intensity without vulgarity, grandeur as opposed muscle, elegance before clout and harmony that is the privilege of very fine wine.
